Barney's is Gone!!

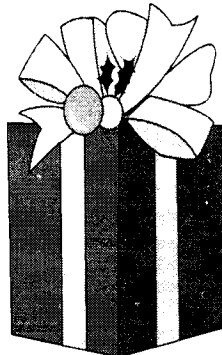
We will hopefully have pavement and will be moving the employee parking area there before the snow flies.

Employee Spotlight

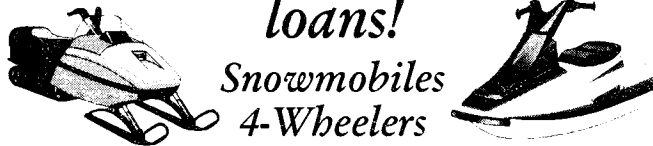
This quarter's spotlight employee is Diana Johnson who has retired after serving our members for 6 years in our Negaunee office. Thank you, Diana. You will be missed.
