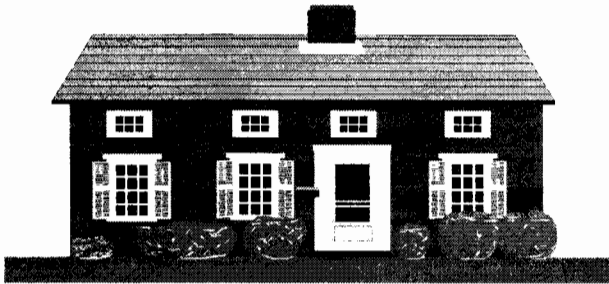
Employee Spotlight
